

We should all be deeply troubled by the excessive compensation that taxpayers are providing to the CEO of the Richmond Olympic Oval Corporation for 2023.

The salary of this individual is nearly on par with that of the Chief Administrative Officer responsible for overseeing all city departments.

Furthermore, it exceeds the total earnings of the Director of Recreation and Sport for the entire city by \$188,000.

The current Council has appointed a new Board comprising 10 Directors who are diligently working to meet their fiduciary responsibilities.

I have been informed that the CEO position at the Oval will not be filled, in addition to another staff member whose compensation was \$181,000.

As a Council, we have a duty to ensure that Richmond taxpayers receive value for their investments, and we must hold accountable those who allowed this situation to occur.
